



## **INDUSTRY SUPPORTED SYMPOSIUM APPLICATION | RULES & REGULATIONS**

The FSGO Program Committee is accepting applications for Industry Supported Symposia (ISS). Submit your application here.

**Application deadline: April 15, 2026**

### **OVERVIEW**

Limited industry supported symposium opportunities are available in the 2026 program.

- The FSGO will not offer Continuing Education (CE) credit for this program. Those wishing to offer accredited education must be directly accredited or obtain accreditation from a source other than FSGO
- Two (2) 75 Minute lunchtime slots will be offered. Exact timing subject to change
- Two (2) 50 Minute breakfast time slots will be offered. Exact timing subject to change
- FSGO volunteer leaders will review applications and make the final decision on which program will be presented.

### **FEES**

The fee for the lunchtime symposium is \$35,000 and breakfast symposium will be \$17,500 and includes:

- Meeting room assigned in advance
- Registration table set outside the session room
- Promotion in one FSGO pre-meeting e-mail blast
- Listing of session title and faculty on the FSGO 2026 Annual Meeting webpage, in the official FSGO program, and included in the on-site- schedule and onsite signage
- Standard FSGO audio visual equipment including an LCD projector, screen, podium microphone, and two table microphones
- Food and beverage is not included in the symposium fee to FSGO and you will be required to offer a boxed lunch as part of the session for up to 100 participants.
- Lunch supporters become an executive platinum supporter, and a tabletop exhibit will be provided with a larger area for the exhibit for the symposium level
- Breakfast symposium will become a platinum supporter, and a tabletop exhibit and six-foot area will be provided

#### **Additional Opportunities, at the expense of the supporting company**

- Required: Food and beverage: costs dependent on selections from the hotel catering menu
- Hotel room door drop to all FSGO attendees staying at the Resort at Longboat Key: \$2,500
- Audience Response System: \$5,000

## **OVERVIEW OF INDUSTRY SUPPORTED SYMPOSIA/RULES & REGULATIONS**

- All symposia are held within the hotel venue
- There are two symposium opportunities this year:
- 75- & 50-minute lunchtime/breakfast sessions slot will be provided. *Exact timing subject to change.* It is recommended to be a Platinum Sponsor at the Annual Meeting which will include the cost of the ISS. (The cost of the ISS lunch application fee of \$35,000 will be credited towards the Executive Platinum Supporter sponsorship amount and the ISS breakfast session application fee of \$17,500 will be credited towards the Platinum Supporter sponsorship amount)
- You have the opportunity of working with your own agency, or with the GOG to develop the content of the program. Note that there are several requirements to work through the GOG and details will be shared via a customized proposal.
- If you opt to work with the GOG on your content development, our team will provide a detailed proposal to manage your company's education. All content development will be done by ACCME standards and accreditation for the program can be offered through the GOG for an additional fee.
- FSGO will provide signage directing attendees to the session room.
- No signage from ISS Industry Partner will be allowed except within an exhibit booth.
- Industry partners are responsible for speaker management and all costs associated, travel, and hotel costs.
- ISS sponsor must use the FSGO designated audio/visual company.
- Sponsor is responsible for promoting this event. FSGO will not guarantee attendance. Industry partners are prohibited from using FSGO's logo. You may list the session as follows: "An Independent Satellite Symposium during the FSGO Annual Meeting."
- Promotional material must not imply that the ISS was planned, sponsored or endorsed by FSGO.
- FSGO must review and approve all marketing or promotional materials that will be disseminated prior to, and in conjunction with, the ISS before the materials are printed.

## **REQUIRED FEES**

Fees shall include the required Application Fee plus the Required Additional Logistic Expenses described below plus any additional cost of services requested.

**The application fee to FSGO for the luncheon symposium is \$35,000 or breakfast session at \$17,500A non-refundable deposit of 5% or \$1,750 USD for the lunchtime symposium and \$875 USD for the breakfast symposium is required with the application. *Applicant acknowledges that the request and required amount of the non-refundable deposit of \$1,750 USD or \$875 USD respectively is reasonable due to the nature, efforts of production and location of the Annual Meeting (See below for logistical fees required for onsite and virtual management of sessions)\*. The deposit must be paid at the time of application submission and if accepted, will be credited to the symposium fee.***

- The Industry Supported Symposia (ISS) is an exclusive component of the Executive Platinum Supporter (lunch ISS) and/or Platinum Supporter (breakfast ISS) Package only.
- FSGO will provide signage directing attendees to the session room.
- No signage from ISS Industry Partner will be allowed except within an exhibit booth.
- Industry partners are responsible for speaker management and all costs associated, travel, and hotel costs.
- ISS sponsor must use the FSGO designated audio/visual company.

**FSGO's ISS Fee includes the following:**

- GOG will also share the content of the symposium for up to an additional six months, pending company compliance rules/guidelines.
- Marketing – session title, faculty, description, and agenda listed in the following locations:

  - Annual Meeting Digital Program Book
- One sign provided by organization for onsite use in booth and outside of congress meeting room 15 min prior to session start time.

**Required Additional Logistic Expenses (not included in ISS Fee)- will be provided in a separate proposal/**

- Onsite Management, including ensuring\*:

- A non-refundable application fee of \$1,750 or \$875 USD will be collected as part of the application process.

- Course Description and Learning Objectives
- Proposed Faculty
